

Amenities

- The Nearest supermarket (Pingo Doce) is just before Ourique on the N123. The fresh meat, bread and veg here are very good. The local wines are worth exploring too. There's a pharmacy next to the supermarket too. There's a Lidl supermarket in Odemira. Left at the tin tree, over the bridge, up the hill and turn right towards Vila Nova de Milfontes. The Lidl is on the right.
- Although the supermarkets don't close at lunch most regular shops close between 13:00 and 15:00. Banks stay open but the close at 15:00. Most shops are open on Sundays.
- There are ATM's (cash machines) at Pingo Doce and in the centre of Ourique. Also in Lidl, Odemira, Cercal and most towns.
- The nearest petrol station is in Colos 5km. Turn right at the bottom of the drive on the N389 and simply keep on the main road through Colos and you'll see it on your left. To park for petrol here you need to be facing back towards the mill as it's a roadside pump. Nice friendly man or woman will fill you up – they understands hand signals. Unleaded is 'sem chumbo 95' and full is 'cheio' pronounced shayoo. On the corner next to the petrol station is a bar with a very good restaurant at the back. Also there are petrol stations one at the Pingo Doce in Ourique, in Odemira, Cercal and south of Ourique on the IC1.
- Santa Luzia has a butcher, 2 small shops, a Post Office and 2 bars, the one furthest from the mill has a restaurant at the back (the bar itself allows smoking). The butcher is renowned and does great pork and veg too.



- For emergencies call 112. There's a hospital in Ourique. See map. It's the building directly in front of you when you drive up the hill - the entrance is the door on the front.
